Abstract: This collection documents the everyday, professional, and philanthropic life of several members of the Kingsbury family. While the collection is largely paper based, there are also publications related to the Kingsbury family, daybooks, account ledgers, a scrapbook, daguerreotypes, an ambrotype, a tintype, cart de visites, cabinet cards, and photograph albums. There is also a small amount of material relating to the Kingsbury's use of indentured servants or house slaves.

Biographical or Organization History:

The Kingsbury family was a significant Waterburian family. The Mattatuck recognizes that the Kingsbury family had a history of employing indentured servants and possibly female house slaves – and that they directly profited on unpaid labor and the violence of slavery. More can be found about Rosetta – the colored girl purchased by Charles Kingsbury – in the archive including the paper purchasing her, and a daguerreotype depicting a colored woman who is possibly Rosetta.

Frederick J. Kingsbury graduated from Yale in 1845. He served as president of Scovill Manufacturing Company from 1868 into the early 1900's and he helped to organize the Silas Bronson Library, the Mattatuck Historical Society, the Waterbury Hospital, and Riverside Cemetery. In 1876, designed the City of Waterbury Seal.

The Kingsbury Family was also involved with the development of the Mattatuck Historical Society.

Scope and Content Note:

Contains the Papers of Alice Kingsbury, Charles D. and Eliza Leavenworth Kingsbury, Judge John Kingsbury, Frederick J. Kingsbury and Alatheia Scovill Kingsbury, spanning the period from 1783 through 1937. The collection is largely paper based, but also contains publications related to the Kingsbury family, daybooks, diaries, account ledgers, a scrapbook, daguerreotypes, an ambrotype, a tintype, cart de visites, cabinet cards, and photograph albums.
